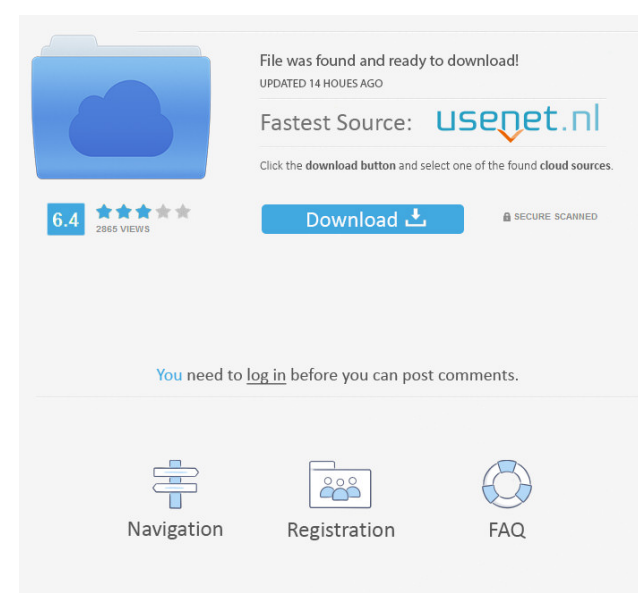

Getting error while using "LIKE" condition in LINQ I have a table which contains following columns id, name, description, state_id I am trying to fetch records where the name is "LIKE" "John" But i am getting the following error System.NotSupportedException: Cannot translate operator 'LIKE' into SQL and no translatable operator is available I have tried with the following code var result = db.State.Where(p => p.Name.Contains("John")).ToList(); But no luck. I am using EntityFramework 5.0.0 Try this: var result = db.State.Where(p => p.Name.Contains("John") || p.Description.Contains("John")).ToList(); You could also use the String.Contains extension method if you have some specific reason to use the Contains method. var result = db.State.Where(p => String.Contains(p.Name, "John") || String.Contains(p.Description, "John")).ToList(); I think you are searching for db.State.Where(p => p.Name == "John" || p.Description == "John") db.State.Where(p => p.Name.Contains("John 82157476af

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
